

Dear Saints Peter and Paul Parents,

As you know, Saints Peter and Paul offers tuition assistance to many families throughout the year who may be in financial need. The deadline for applying for tuition assistance is March 1<sup>st</sup>. When you apply by March 1<sup>st</sup>, make sure that you indicate that you are applying both for assistance for the Diocese of Joliet and Saints Peter and Paul School. Both the parish and the Diocese offer assistance, but the assistance from the Diocese requires that you apply before March 1<sup>st</sup>. This can make significant difference in the amount of assistance that you receive so please apply early. If you are unsure whether you will need assistance next year, you are still encouraged to apply. You can always reimburse the parish or the Diocese should the funds not be needed.

Please note that the tuition assistance procedures are the same as in the previous year. First, paper applications are not longer accepted by FACTS. Only electronic applications are accepted. Second, the tuition assistance login is found at the same location as your FACTS financial enrollment simply click on this link: <https://online.factsmgmt.com/signin/3G6T5>. You will simply use the login you use to access your FACTS tuition payment plan. Third, FACTS charges a \$ 30 processing fee to all applicants. Please notice that there is only one fee per family no matter the number of institutions for which a particular family is applying for assistance. Fourth, there are a series of questions which allow you to give more information about your situation.

**PLEASE NOTICE THAT TUITION ASSISTANCE APPLICATIONS FOR THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR CAN BE FILED AFTER JANUARY 15<sup>TH</sup> AND SHOULD BE FILED BEFORE MARCH 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2018.**
